

Laurier Avenue East Rehabilitation

LEA Consulting Ltd. was retained by the Transportation Department of the Regional Municipality of Ottawa-Carleton (RMOC) in August 1994 to undertake preliminary design, detailed design and preparation of tender documents for the reconstruction of 1.3 km of Laurier Avenue from Nicholas Street to Charlotte Street.



The scope of work included the design of watermain, sanitary and storm sewers to replace the existing combined sewer and watermain along Laurier Avenue and reconstruction of the road.

Extensive coordination with utility companies, City of Ottawa and RMOC was undertaken to obtain as-built plans of existing municipal services and utilities. The locations and elevations of all existing services were confirmed in the field.

In order to receive public's comments and concerns regarding this project, a public information

centre was held November 1994 and again in June 1995 to receive comments on the preliminary design.

The project is scheduled to be completed in December 1995 with possible construction in 1996.

The estimated construction value is \$ 4,020,000.00.
