Detailed Narrative Description of Project:			
<p>The Project involved the upgrading of approximately 160 km of rural access roads and the replacement of 44 bridges throughout Trinidad and Tobago. The construction works were undertaken by contract in three (3) phases:</p> <p>Phase I: Improvement of 12 agricultural access roads for a total of 25 km in a contract period of 12 months; and the replacement of 12 bridges in a contract period of 15 months.</p> <p>Phase II: Improvement of 22 access roads for a total length of 50 km in an estimated construction period of 10 months; and the replacement of 16 bridges in an estimated time of construction of 18-20 months.</p> <p>Phase III: Improvement of an additional 85 km of roads; and the replacement of 16 bridges.</p> <p>Funding for both construction and supervision services was provided through an Inter-American Development Bank Loan and direct allocation from the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago.</p>
